FAMILY CODE: 31404

A throttle body is a tube-shaped housing that contains a flat valve (butterfly) that rotates to vary the amount of air entering an engine.







• Dismantle, clean, and scour the part




The throttle body must be replaced when:

- There is a lack of power
- The engine has lost power



- ECU
- Plugs
- Air filter
